NECESSARY PROCEDURES FOR APPLICATION TO THE UP COLLEGE OF MUSIC

1. Proceed to the College Secretary's Office for the Application Form, Information Bulletin & Audition Requirements. Application forms may be downloaded *via www.music.upd.edu.ph*.
2. Submit your application form for processing with supporting documents. Please check the lower portion of your application form (some documents require originals and some accept photocopies)
3. Pay your P500.00 –Testing fee to the UP Cashiers Office, 2nd floor PNB Bldg.
4. Bring your Official Receipt to the College Secretary's Office for issuance of test permit.
5. Come back on Saturday, March 08, 2014 for the Music Theory Exam. Bring your Test Permit and pencil. You are required to be in the building at 8:00 am. Eat a good breakfast & be early so you can relax.
6. Only students who pass the Music Theory Exam can take the Talent Audition. Exam results will be posted on Wednesday, March 12, 2014, 4:00 pm on the College Secretary's Office Bulletin Board.
7. Talent Audition - See posters for date, time schedule & room assignment.
8. Names of admitted students for the 1st Semester AY 2014-2015 will be posted on Monday, 07 April 2014 4:00PM on the CSO Bulletin Board. See Ms. Connie/Ms. Ely for Admission Requirements.

ONLY students who confirm their intent to enroll by a deadline set by the college are considered accepted.
