## REQUIREMENTS FOR GRADUATE ADMISSION

- 1) A Bachelor of Music (BM) degree, or its equivalent, from a fully accredited institution. Each applicant must submit a scanned copy of the original diploma or an equivalent document through email.
- 2) Transcript of records (undergraduate; graduate work, if any). Email a scanned copy of the original. The hard copy will be sent later upon request.
- 3) Accomplished Application forms for admission (Application Form No. 1).
- 4) Accomplished recommendation forms from at least two (2) professors or experts in your field (Application Form No. 2).
- 5) A cumulative grade average of 2.0 (B) or better in the undergraduate work.
- 6) Interview with the graduate advisor of the intended major area to determine specific requirements in the intended area.
- 7) Talent audition in the major instrument or voice (see Admission Schedule). Applicants are encouraged to email a video (in mp4, etc. format) or audio recording (mp3 format) of the applicant's repertoire early before the scheduled audition at the College of Music.
- 8) Proof of English proficiency for foreign applicants whose native language is not English. A score of at least 500 in the Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL) is required.
- 9) For prospective Musicology majors, two academic writing samples (15-20 pages each).
- 10) Three (3) copies of recent photo (2" X 2")
- 11) Graduate Placement Exam
